This role works as a part of Production Control to support the Master Schedule by planning, tracking WIP and maintaining Line-Of-Balance on parts. Supports Customer Service by providing accurate and up-to-date information, and works to overcome challenges faced in the manufacture of products in order to achieve on-time delivery.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Reviews the customer MRP requirements and assists the Master Scheduler with planning of production resources and the preparation and maintenance of the Master Production Schedule accordingly to meet and/or exceed the customer's requirements.
- Uses the existing tools and reports within Visual Manufacturing ERP to plan and execute production to achieve and exceed 100% on time delivery to customer MRP requirements
- Works to define and eliminate variations between the Visual Manufacturing ERP database information as it relates to WIP position and part count, including nonconforming parts.
- Communicates production plan with Manufacturing Supervisor. Monitors the output from the shop floor to assure that the production plan is being properly executed and provides feedback to the Manufacturing Supervisor and Production Control Master Scheduler.
- Tracks WIP parts throughout the facility to ensure production schedule is flowing as planned, and communicates regularly with Master Scheduler to keep informed on status of parts in WIP.
