Troubleshoots mechanical, pneumatic, hydraulic, electrical and electronic systems to resolve breakdowns or make repairs. Functions as a part of the Facilities Maintenance team to perform other general work required throughout the facility and maintain the systems running at maximum efficiency.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Responsible for the maintenance, installation, repair, and upkeep of equipment, machinery and the facilities. Advanced mechanical skills and experience necessary in working on CNC machinery, hydraulic and pneumatic systems, and computerized electronic controls.
- Ensures operation of machinery and mechanical equipment by completing preventive maintenance requirements on engines, motors, pneumatic tools, and production machines; following diagrams, sketches, operations manuals, manufacturer's instructions, and engineering specifications; Installs, repairs and maintains machines, equipment, and facility in accordance with plans and procedures.
- Diagnoses malfunctions, and troubleshoots systems to determine required repair, to dismantle, to replace, to adjust, and/or assemble. Locates sources of problems by observing mechanical devices in operation; listening for problems; using precision measuring and testing instruments to tests machines and equipment for operating characteristics, and orders repair/replacement of parts.
- Devises methods of altering machinery and equipment to improve operating characteristics within the principles of Continuous Improvement. May perform electronic maintenance, machine repair, and plumbing duties
- Maintains safe and clean working environment by complying with procedures, rules, and regulations.
- Contributes to team effort by prioritizing workload and accomplishing related results as needed.
- Performs vehicle and material handling equipment maintenance. May perform grounds and buildings general maintenance, paint, or perform carpentry duties as necessary. May also operate and maintain heavy equipment.
- Some assignments may require skills in carpentry, plumbing, and repair of machinery, mechanical equipment, electrical circuits and appliances.
